Allocation of funding

The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. Funding has been allocated using a proxy measure for disadvantaged: learners with low prior attainment, meaning those who did not have a GCSE grade 4 or above in English and/or maths at age 16.

All students supported have been identified as not achieving grade 5 or above in at least one of those subjects at this level by age 16 and are on a 16 to 19 study programme.

In Year 12 students have been selected by targeting GCSE Grade 5+ in English and Maths.

In Year 13 students have been selected where they are at least 2 grades below their target grade.

2 Year 12 students in GCSE Maths with 10 hours tuition from HLTA, targeting Grade 5+	£336.50
2 Year 12 students in GCSE English with 10 hours tuition from HLTA, targeting Grade 5+	£336.50
3 Year 13 students in A Level RS or Sociology with 10 hours tuition through MyTutor, to improve grades towards targets (2 grades below)	£600
