On 29 January 2021, our parent remote learning survey was distributed to all of our families. I would like to say thank to everyone that took the time to complete the survey.

Parents were asked question around three themes; remote teaching and learning provision, well-being and virtual events. It is important we continually hear from our parents about what we are doing well, and what we could improve but it is especially important at this time when our community is not all together on site. This summary report I am sharing with you is our first communication, and provides an overview of key messages and top line results from the survey. We will now focus on how we respond to the survey so that we can improve upon our current strong remote learning provision and build on what currently works well.

Parents gave us 4 stars out of 5 for our remote learning provision

85% of parents who knew said they had seen an improvement in our remote learning provision since the first lockdown.

73% of parents agreeing or strongly agreeing that we are setting the right amount of work, with clear instructions.


74% of parents said that their children are coping well at home and with their work.

98% of parents reported their child knows how to stay safe online.




