The English Department are delighted that school trips are back on!

We are thrilled to be able to bring Year 10 students on a day trip to London to see a live performance of their GCSE English Literature play 'Macbeth' on Monday 28th March at 2pm at The Globe Theatre. This is where the 'Scottish play' would have been originally performed in 1605 and this immersive experience will no doubt be the best revision. We will also take the opportunity to take the students on a walking tour of the Southside Embankment.

The total cost of this trip is £35 to cover the cost of the ferry and a yard ticket at the Globe and we would appreciate a voluntary contribution to cover this.

The trip will begin at 8.00am and end at approximately 9.00pm and students will be returned to the academy by coach or dropped off at the East Cowes Ferry Terminal. Please indicate on the attached consent form if your child will be meeting staff at East Cowes Red Funnel Ferry Terminal in the morning, and if they will be collected from East Cowes Ferry Terminal or the academy in the evening.

Below is an itinerary for the visit:

- **8.00am** Meet at Cowes Enterprise Car Park and board coaches
- **8.30am** Students who wish may meet a member of staff at the East Cowes Red Funnel Ferry Terminal (please indicate bus boarding and drop off on attached permission form)
- **9.00am** Red Funnel Ferry to Southampton
- **2.00pm** Performance at the globe
- **8.30pm** Collection from East Cowes Ferry Terminal
- **9.00pm** Arrive Back at Cowes Enterprise College Car Park

Students are expected to wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch, bottle of water and snacks. If your child is eligible for free school meals please let us know and a packed lunch will be provided for them on the day.
