We are extremely excited that on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January**, we will be taking your child to the Mary Rose Museum in Portsmouth Historic Dockyard as part of their Maritime History topic. This is an incredible opportunity for the entire year group – and something that is being supported by a number of local businesses to make it possible.

Whilst at the Museum, the trust have prepared a selection of activities and workshops for the students to take part in which are designed to support their project-based work over the next 6 weeks.

In order to make sure that every student has an opportunity to ask questions relating to their own individual project, we will be taking different classes on separate days. This will also enable groups to rotate around the various activities and spend a sufficient amount of time in the museum itself.

Therefore, I can confirm that your child will be visiting the centre on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January**. We will be leaving Cowes Enterprise College at 8am (Please ensure that your child arrives before 8am) and travelling via a private chartered boat to Portsmouth and returning to **Cowes at 3.45pm**. Collection will be from Solent Cruises next to the Floating Bridge. Alternatively, you can give permission for your child to walk home.

Students should arrive as normal for school, in uniform and bring a packed lunch, coat, snack and plenty of water. If your child is eligible for free school meals, please let us know by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> January and a packed lunch will be provided for them on the day.
