Dear Parent / Carer,

RE: Year 11 End of Term Arrangements – Summer 2024

I am writing with further information on the final GCSE examinations and the end of term arrangements. We will shortly be sending home an envelope containing another copy of your child's exam timetable, some useful guidance along with important information on the exam procedures and regulations. Year 11 students are expected to continue to attend the academy as usual, attending exams and lessons, when not in exams, as per their timetable, until Monday 10th June. From Tuesday 11th June, students will only be expected to attend for their exams and the specific activities outlined below.

Thursday 13th June

- Students studying Geography will be expected to attend the Academy from 8:50am for a final revision session led by the Geography team.
- Students who do not study geography will be expected to attend from 9:50am for a final Science revision session led by the Science team.
- Following breaktime all Year 11 students will have their 'Leavers' Assembly'.
- Students will be dismissed from the Academy at 12:10pm.

Friday 14th June

- All Students to attend for their exams as per the exams timetable.
- Students will be able to leave the academy following the completion of their exams.

Monday 17th to Wednesday 19th June

- Students only attend for their exams (Music, Polish, Portuguese, DT and Food)

Although we fully expect the exams to run smoothly, the authorities have set a national contingency date on Wednesday 26th June, for in the event of national or significant local disruption. UK students sitting exams in summer 2024 need to be available to sit exams on this day, regardless of whether they have exams scheduled or not.

The Leaver's Assembly is a great way to mark the end of the requirement to attend the Academy full-time. Following the assembly, students usually enjoy the opportunity to sign their shirts as a souvenir of their time at CEC. If they do wish to do this, please bear in mind that students will not be able to wear signed shirts in any subsequent exams.

The Year 11 Prom will be held at Northwood House on Thursday 4th July at 7pm. The GCSE results day is on Thursday 22nd August and we will write to you again in July, with more information on this.
