

Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope this letter finds you well. We are writing to inform you about an exciting development regarding our school uniform. After carefully considering feedback from both students and families since the summer term last year, we are looking to make some positive changes to the uniform in order to significantly reduce cost and make it more comfortable for our students to wear.

We are aware that changes to uniform can have financial implications for families, and as such, we want to make it clear that we will not be mandating that families of existing students purchase the new uniform immediately. The transition will be gradual, allowing students to wear their current uniform while gradually switching over to the new one. If changes are made it will become compulsory for the new Year 7 intake starting September 2025 and roll out over time to the rest of the school.

The new uniform has been designed with the needs of our students in mind, ensuring that it is both affordable and practical. This change comes in response to the voices of our students, who have shared their thoughts on how the current uniform can be improved for comfort and ease of wear.

In order to ensure that we are listening to the whole school community and beyond, we would greatly appreciate your feedback on the proposed changes.
