Shirts	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CEC logo polo shirt • Plain white polo shirt worn under CEC logo jumper 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain white polo with no CEC logo IF worn without a CEC logo jumper 
Jumpers	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CEC logo black jumper 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black jumpers with ANY logo EXCEPT the CEC logo • Jumpers which are not black • Hoodies or coats worn indoors 
Trousers/Skirts/Shorts	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smart black trousers, must be loose-fitting and about the same width from knee to ankle, not skinny fit or cropped length • A black pleated skirt or smart black shorts which MUST worn at knee length or below, unless worn with plain black tights or plain black leggings underneath 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Skinny' fit trousers • Jeans, tracksuit bottoms or leggings (worn without a skirt) • Tight 'body-con' skirt • Any skirt or shorts worn above knee length UNLESS worn with plain black tights or leggings • Cargo-style shorts with pockets 
Shoes	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain black school shoes or trainers (absolutely no logos). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School shoes or trainers in any other colour than plain black, or with logos • Boots • Heels • Open toes, sling-backs, etc. 
Accessories, hair and make-up	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One simply stud or sleeper worn in the lobe of each ear • Non-visible make up • Hairstyles should be moderate and appropriate for school, including natural hair and protected hairstyles associated with their racial, ethnic and cultural identities • A wristwatch (not a smart watch) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any jewellery other than one simple stud or sleeper in the lobe of each ear • Facial piercings • Smart watches • Visible make-up including false eyelashes • Nail varnish unless clear in colour including false nails • Haircuts which are less than grade 1, markings, tramlines or symbols • Hair dye is not recommended for children at secondary school age. However, if used, hair colour should remain natural and not undermine our high standards of appearance
