<b>Shirts</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>White shirt or revere collared blouse (MUST be worn tucked in, WITH one item with CEC Logo/Tartan such as: blazer, logo black jumper or tie)</li> <li>CEC logo polo shirt</li> <li>Plain white polo shirt worn under CEC logo jumper</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>White shirt or blouse worn untucked</li> <li>White shirt or blouse worn without either a blazer, tie or CEC logo jumper</li> <li>Plain white polo with no CEC logo IF worn without a CEC logo jumper</li> </ul> 
<b>Jumpers</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CEC logo black jumper</li> <li>Plain black v-neck jumper IF worn with tie/blazer</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Black jumpers with ANY logo EXCEPT the CEC logo</li> <li>Jumpers which are not black</li> <li>Hoodies or coats worn indoors</li> </ul> 
<b>Trousers/Skirts/Shorts</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Smart black trousers, must be loose-fitting and about the same width from knee to ankle, not skinny fit or cropped length</li> <li>A black pleated skirt or academy tartan kilt or smart black shorts which MUST worn at knee length or below, unless worn with plain black tights or plain black leggings underneath</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>'Skinny' fit trousers</li> <li>Jeans, tracksuit bottoms or leggings (worn without a skirt)</li> <li>Tight 'body-con' skirt</li> <li>Any skirt or shorts worn above knee length UNLESS worn with plain black tights or leggings</li> </ul> 
<b>Shoes</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plain black school shoes or trainers (absolutely no logos).</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>School shoes or trainers in any other colour than plain black, or with logos</li> <li>Boots</li> <li>Heels</li> <li>Open toes, sling-backs, etc.</li> </ul> 
<b>Accessories, hair and make-up</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One simply stud or sleeper worn in the lobe of each ear</li> <li>Non-visible make up</li> <li>Hairstyles should be moderate and appropriate for school, including natural hair and protected hairstyles associated with their racial, ethnic and cultural identities</li> <li>A wristwatch (not a smart watch)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any jewellery other than one simple study or sleeper in the lobe of each ear</li> <li>Facial piercings</li> <li>Smart watches</li> <li>Visible make-up including false eyelashes</li> <li>Nail varnish unless clear in colour including false nails</li> <li>Haircuts which are less than grade 1, markings, tramlines or symbols</li> <li>Hair dye is not recommended for children at secondary school age. However, if used, hair colour should remain natural and not undermine our high standards of appearance</li> </ul>
