#### **Show My Homework**

This year we are continuing to use Show My Homework to set an monitor homework at the Academy. Hopefully, you found it a useful tool to help you and your child manage their homework. At the beginning of the new school year, we wanted to send out a few reminders about how to use the service and details of how to access help if needed.

## Year 7 pupils & parents:

- Very shortly, all parents of pupils in Year 7 will receive a letter containing Show My Homework login details for yourself and your child, along with simple instructions to set up both the parental and pupil accounts
- Students will also have an assembly next week to explain how Show My Homework works

#### Pupils & parents in other year groups:

- Pupils who were in the Academy during the last academic year should be able to continue to use their login details from last year
- This should consist of their <u>school email address</u> and a password of their choice
- If pupils have forgotten their password, they can use the forgotten password link on the login page at showmyhomework.co.uk. This will then send a password re-set link to their school email account
- A few students also changed the email address associated with their accounts from their school email address to a personal one. If your child cannot login or re-set their password, please try entering any other email addresses which could have been used
- If parents have forgotten their login details, these can be re-set using the forgotten password link described above and using your personal email address used when setting up the account
- If you cannot reset both the pupil and parental passwords, please make sure the whole email address is entered correctly.

  Misspelling of addresses is often the most common cause of login problems
- If you or your child cannot reset password or access re-set emails from an account, please contact your child's progress mentor. They will be able to reissue you and your child a personalised PIN number which will reset your account. You will be able to re-enter your email address and set a new password for pupils, please can we suggest that this is their school email address

Show My homework is best accessed on a PC, Mac, laptop or tablet using a web browser. There is a Show My Homework app available on iOS and Android devices, but these can be temperamental.

To access help online, please visit <a href="www.showmyhomework.co.uk">www.showmyhomework.co.uk</a> and click on 'support'. This will give you access to very straightforward step by step guides to using Show My Homework. Please do contact your child's Progress Mentor the Academy if you or your child cannot access the internet at home for any length of time to ensure that we can put things in place to support you. Similarly, please let us know if you need additional parental accounts to be set up.

At the Academy, pupils, as last year, can access PCs in the library at lunchtime and after school. Pupils can also use these computers to print out any resources they might need. The expectation, however, is that resources will be scanned onto Show My Homework or paper copies given out to pupils (if essential) and therefore there should be no need to print resources at home.

Please do not hesitate to contact the Academy if you need any further guidance.


